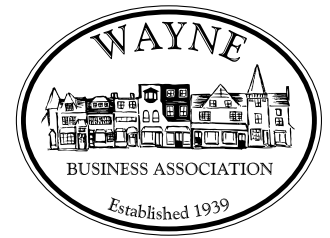

### Ribbon Cutting and Anniversary Ceremonies

### Discount Merchant/Employee Parking

The WBA negotiated discount parking for Wayne Business Overlay District (WBOD) merchants and employees. ### Opportunities to Volunteer with the WBA

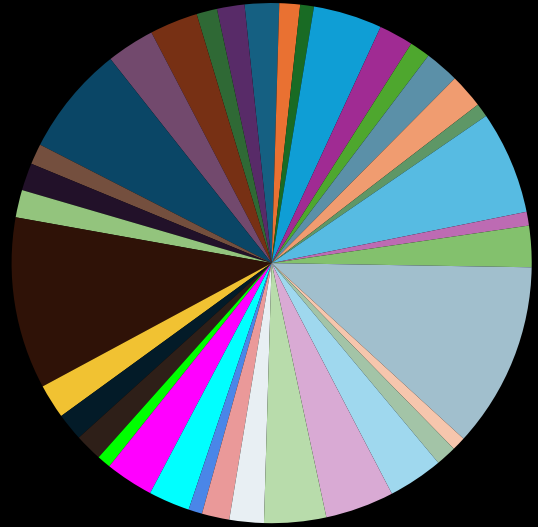

## THE LEAGUE OF WOMEN VOTERS OF RADNOR TOWNSHIP WILL HOLD ITS ANNUAL TOAST TO TENACITY ON SUNDAY, AUGUST 18, 2:00 TO 4:00 PM, IN THE WINSOR ROOM AT RADNOR MEMORIAL LIBRARY

The League of Women Voters toast the thousands of brave women who won the vote for American women through the ratification of the Nineteenth Amendment to the U.S. Constitution on August 26, 1920. They traditionally toast in grape juice since Prohibition was in effect.

Local actor Pat Jordan will portray Carrie Chapman Catt, the leader of the months-long effort to win the vote on the amendment in the Tennessee legislature and make Tennessee the 36th state, the final state required for ratification before the allotted time expired. That August, the enfranchisement of millions of women was at stake.

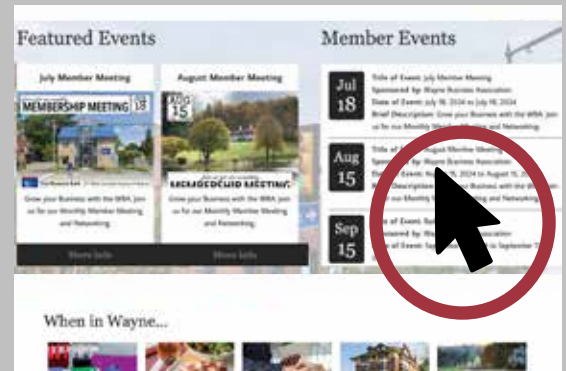
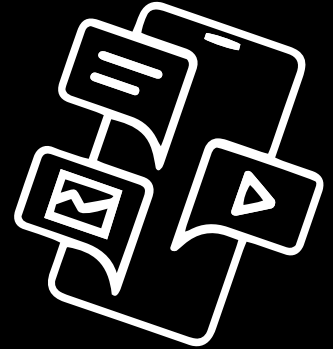
